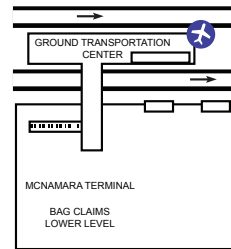

Where

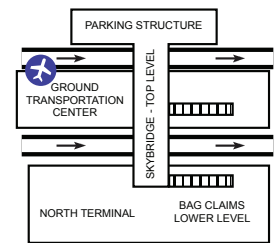
ISAC/airBus picks up at both of Detroit Metro Airport's terminals:

McNamara Terminal



After claiming your bags, go up one level to the skywalk. Cross to the Ground Transportation Center and go down the escalator to the right. Board the bus near the rental car shuttles.

North Terminal



After claiming your bags, go up one level to the skywalk. Cross to the Ground Transportation Center and go down the escalator. Make a "u-turn" at the bottom and board at the bus loading area.

Made possible by Michigan Student Assembly and Rackham Student Government, International Student Affairs Commission and MSA airBus have teamed up to offer easy, inexpensive transport to Ann Arbor. When your bus arrives in Ann Arbor, several international student groups will be awaiting you at the State Street bus stop (the first stop) to provide useful resources.

Get ready to ride...

Ride the bus that's most convenient for you -- no reservation is required. Hand us your ISAC/airBus Boarding Pass when you get on -- the \$12 fare is charged automatically to your student account. All trips drop off:

on **State Street**, near the Michigan Union, South Quad, West Quad and East Quad

on **Observatory Street**, near Mosher-Jordan, Alice Lloyd, Couzens, Stockwell and Markley

at **Bursley Hall**, a short campus bus ride from Baits and all areas of Northwood

Used airBus before?

ISAC/airBus is a pilot project, so there's a few things that make it different from the airBus you're used to. Rather than running at frequent intervals, we're starting with a basic service level to test this travel season. And instead of swiping your Mcard, print an ISAC/airBus Boarding Pass and fill in your UMID; hand it to us when you board the bus.
